Devotions – May 2013

Introduction

We continue working through Dietrich Bonhoeffer's exposition on the Sermon on the Mount in his book 'The Cost of Discipleship'. Last month we looked at the section called the Beatitudes (or 'blessings'). This month's reading is addressed to the same audience – those who called by the grace of God to be disciples of Christ.

The Reading

^{Matt 5:13}“You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet.

¹⁴“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. (ESV)

The teaching

We may have felt last month that the blessed ones of the beatitudes were too good for this world, and only fit to live in heaven. This month's passage calls these same people the 'salt of the earth'. In our generation, with modern food preservation techniques, we have lost the essential nature of salt. However, in earlier generations every hearer would have known that salt was the essential factor in preserving many different kinds of food, and was therefore basically essential to the very preservation of life itself. So to call disciples (that is those who follow Jesus Christ and call him Lord) the salt of the earth is to say that disciples are the highest good, the supreme value that the world possesses, that they are the salt that preserves the world, and that they exist, for the sake of the world. As disciples then, we can't just think of heaven, we have an earthly task as well. We have been entrusted with the work of Jesus on this earth.

Note that the passage does not say that we *must* be the salt (that is something that we can become) or to *have* the salt (that is something we can get) but that we *are* the salt, we have been made salt by the very calling that we have received.

The passage also raises the possibility that the salt may lose its saltiness. It just stops working and is worthless, and only fit to be thrown away. That is the point of salt, it seasons everything else, but it cannot itself be seasoned. That is the judgement that hangs over the disciple community, the Church, whose mission is to save the world, but which, if it ceases to live up to that calling, is itself irretrievably lost.

The call of Jesus makes the disciple community not only salt, but also the 'light of the world'; our activity is to be visible. Once again it is not 'you are *to be* the light', but 'you *are* the light'. We are already the light because Christ has called us. We are a light to be seen by men, and if it is not so, then it is a sign that we have not been called. It is absurd to think that we could try to *become* the light. It is the call of Jesus that has already made us so. Neither is it the case that we *have* the light – it is not an instrument that has been placed in our hands such as preaching, but it is we disciples ourselves. The same Jesus who, speaking of himself, said, “I am the light,” says to his followers “You are the light in your whole existence, provided you remain faithful to your calling. And since you are the light you cannot remain hidden, even if you want to.” It is the property of light to shine. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. The followers are a visible community; our discipleship visible in action which lifts us out of the world.

Men are not to see the disciples, but our good works, says Jesus. And these works are none other than those which the Lord Jesus has created in us by calling us to be the light of the world under the shadow of his cross. The good works are poverty, the attitude of being a sojourner in the world, meekness, peaceableness, and finally persecution and rejection. All these works are a bearing of the cross of Jesus Christ. The cross is a strange light which alone illuminates these good works of the disciples. Jesus does not say that men will see God; they will see the good works and glorify God because of them.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we we accept and respond to your call, losing all claim to our worldly inheritance for your sake, sharing in your good works so that men will see and glorify you and in turn believe in you.
