Devotions – June 2015

Introduction

This year we are looking at Paul's letter to the Ephesians. Last month we saw that the only true source of peace, both between man and God, and also between men is through Jesus Christ expressed in his body, the church. This month, as an aside, Paul shows us the mystery, message and mission of the church.

The Reading

^{Eph 3:1} For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner for Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles—² assuming that you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for you,³ how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have written briefly.⁴ When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ,⁵ which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.⁶ This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.

⁷ Of this gospel I was made a minister according to the gift of God's grace, which was given me by the working of his power.⁸ To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,⁹ and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things,¹⁰ so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.¹¹ This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord,¹² in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him.¹³ So I ask you not to lose heart over what I am suffering for you, which is your glory. (ESV)

The teaching

In the bible the word 'mystery' is used to describe, not so much a secret, but new information, or old information revealed in a new way, just as the Rosetta Stone unlocked the mystery of hieroglyphics, opening up a whole new understanding of Ancient Egypt. The great mystery revealed uniquely to Paul is the bringing together into one body all things under Christ, both Jew and Gentile. This is the context of the only command found in the first 2 chapters – to remember how cut off we were as Gentiles, and how blessed we are to be fellow heirs in the promises of God. It was this new information that was so offensive to Jews of Paul's day that he was imprisoned by them and so became a prisoner on behalf of the Gentiles. Whilst we can see glimpses of the inclusion of the Gentiles in the Old Testament, no one before Paul saw the closeness of the affinity we all have as the one body of Christ, both Jew and Gentile. It is the bond that is closer than even the closest of human relationships such as between husband and wife or mother and child. These are still relationships between two bodies, but God's people are one body. So don't be surprised or dismayed that there are secrets in your life that you can share with a brother or sister in Christ that you are not even able to share with your spouse or family.

Paul had great authority to preach his message, and in vs 2 and 3 he gives a brief background to the authority. But in doing so he remained truly humble, describing himself as the least of the saints. He preached Christ's riches – the promises behind the membership in the body of Christ and the inheritance to come. These are riches wildly beyond anything this world can offer in wealth, fame or power, and those who recognize the riches of the gospel are prepared to make sacrifices to see the message taken into the world. It is this gospel that brings people out of the dark and into the light of God's remarkable purposes. Paul is greatly dismissed by secular people – roles in family and the church, sexual standards, spiritual authority and the uniqueness of Christ. But when people in the church dismiss his teaching they are putting themselves in a very dangerous position.

In vs 10 we see God's great mission for the church is that God's manifold and infinite wisdom might be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. Our mission is to take the message that we have heard as we have gathered as the body of Christ, whether in church week by week, in small groups or here month by month and to take it into the world in whatever context we find ourselves in – in the home, workplace, school or uni, etc taking what we have received to live it out for God's honour, and to the praise of his glory. So we can see that the church that God has brought together is crucial to the Christian life, is crucial for the plans that God has for the world and crucial to his glory.

Prayer

Father, we pray that we may not just hear the gospel, but that we appreciate it, that we don't just understand it, but that we believe it and live it out to the praise of your glory, and the extension of your kingdom.

24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
