# Devotions – March 2016

## Introduction

We continue our series looking at the church, at how God sees his people, not just as a collection of individuals, but as the pinnacle of his creation and the ultimate purpose of our being. This month we see the first gathering of the nation of Israel as God's people.

## The Reading

<sup>Ex 19:1</sup> On the third new moon after the people of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that day they came into the wilderness of Sinai. They set out from Rephidim and came into the wilderness of Sinai, and they encamped in the wilderness. There Israel encamped before the mountain, while Moses went up to God. The Lord called to him out of the mountain, saying, "Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the people of Israel: You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words that you shall speak to the people of Israel."

So Moses came and called the elders of the people and set before them all these words that the Lord had commanded him. All the people answered together and said, "All that the Lord has spoken we will do." And Moses reported the words of the people to the Lord. And the Lord said to Moses, "Behold, I am coming to you in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and may also believe you forever." (ESV)

## The teaching

God is a personal God and he is at work to bring a people into relationship with him. In Genesis Ch 12 God promised Abraham that all the nations would be blessed through him. At that time Abraham had no earthly hope of having one child by his wife, never mind a host of descendants. God began the fulfilment of that promise through the miraculous birth of Isaac, which was continued through Jacob, also known as Israel. 400 years later their descendants the Israelites were a numerous people enslaved in Egypt, when God raised Moses as their deliverer.

Up until this point God had spoken to the Israelites through Moses, but now he gathered them so that he could address them as his people. He said to them 'out of all nations you be my treasured possession', and 'you will be a kingdom of priests and holy nation'. The chapter goes on to describe how the people were to prepare themselves for the occasion by ceremonial washing and abstinence. God set up boundaries, not to distance himself from them, but to allow them to come into his presence without dying. The law was an act of grace that set out God's requirements for righteousness, without which it is impossible to enter into his presence.

Why did God choose the Israelites? They were nothing special, and they had not done anything to deserve this special treatment. They were as sinful as any of the nations around them, but God loved them and called them as his own special people, keeping an oath he had made to their forefathers. His purpose was to use his people to reveal his glory to the nations.

Why does God love us? Is it because we deserve it? No, God has called us out as his own possession, purchasing us at the expense of his own Son's life, not for our benefit (although we do benefit from his grace), but for his benefit, using us to reveal his glory to those around us. We, the people of God, who gather together as his church, do it not just to bask in God's love but to share it with a dying world. As we saw last month from 1 Peter Ch 2 – "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." Do you think of yourself as having a priestly purpose? Do you go to church to feel good, or to equip yourself to bring God's message of love and salvation to a needy world?

## Prayer

Father, thank you for your grace that is poured out into our lives as we submit to your truth, that you make us into a family, into a spiritual house and into your own people, preparing us for works of service that glorify you.

19. **SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:**

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and Log Book (if issued) at document check.

20. **CLASSES:** As per Article 7 of the National Motorkhana Code.

21. **PRIZES AND TROPHIES:** Points towards LBMCCC Championship

Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, including penalties incurred. Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code.

22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.

26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

30. ***Use of prohibited Substances***

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the Anti-Doping Policy will apply

31. A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a Motorkhana as described in 19.1 of the National Motorkhana Code.

Juniors cannot take other juniors as passengers

Event 1 – consists of up to 12 tests run once each. This will determine the placings for the day

Event 2 – consists of two identical tests run simultaneously as a knockout format. Last competitor unbeaten declared winner.

This result does not count towards placings.

Trailers must be moved to the other side of the tunnel once unloaded.
