# Devotions – May 2016

## Introduction

We continue our series looking at the church, at how God sees his people, not just as a collection of individuals, but as the pinnacle of his creation and the ultimate purpose of our being. This month we see that the earthly church is the new true temple of God.

## The Reading

<sup>Eph 2:11</sup> Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called “the uncircumcision” by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands— remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility. And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit. (ESV)

## The teaching

This passage has its emphasis on Christians in the here and now – previously we were enemies, but now we are people of peace, the barriers have been torn down. Ephesians Chapter 1 talks of God’s glorious plan – electing a people for him to love and redeem by the blood of his own Son restoring the vertical relationship with him, and bringing all things together under the one head – Jesus Christ. Chapter 2 continues to develop the theme of restoration of the vertical relation by contrasting where we were before – dead in our sins and relationship to God, but now alive in Christ and in a living relationship with God.

In the past God allocated a physical space where he would meet with his people. People have been seeking peace with God or the gods in many ways ever since the time that God put his Spirit into mankind. We still have the remains of the temples of the Greek and Roman empires, but God was not to be found there. Many Asian cultures build temples to help them worship their ancestors, but God is not to be found there. However, when God brought his people out of Egypt he gave them initially the tabernacle with the ark of the covenant. He placed his glory on it, and he was to be found there. Later on he gave them the temple in Jerusalem, and he placed his glory there. Even though God let his glory rest there, both the tabernacle and the temple were still just shadows of the true reality, and maintained a separation between man and God protected by holy spaces and the ceremonial regulations that governed worship there. When Jesus died on the cross he broke down the barriers. There was no longer any need for an earthly building to house God’s glory, and so he removed his glory from the temple by tearing in two from top to bottom the curtain that separated the people from God’s glory.

God’s glory is now found in all people who are to be found in Christ by his Spirit. He is building his people to be his true dwelling place. We the church are the true dwelling place of God, the true temple built on the foundation of the prophets and apostles with Christ himself as the cornerstone. Our salvation is not an individual affair – we are saved into the people of God by his grace and mercy in order to bring God the glory. This is his purpose to bring all things together under one head – Jesus Christ, in heaven and on earth – Jew, Gentile, young, old, rich, poor, all peoples, races and cultures of the world all together under Christ for his glory and our benefit.

## Prayer

Father, thank you for your grace that is poured out into our lives as we submit to your truth, that you make us into a family, into a spiritual house that is your church and into your own people, preparing us for works of service that glorify you. Amen.

23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
