Devotions – November 2016

Introduction

We continue our series looking at the church, at how God sees his people, not just as a collection of individuals, but as the pinnacle of his creation and the ultimate purpose of our being. This month we look at how to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

The Reading

^{Eph 5:15} Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. ¹⁸ And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹ addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, ²⁰ giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹ submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ. (ESV)

The teaching

Paul has a common pattern in his letters in telling us first of who we are in Christ, and then how we should live it out. The first 3 chapters in this letter spell out who we are in Christ in great detail. Then as he is helping us understand how to live it out he continues to remind us of who we are. For example earlier in this chapter in vs 1 we are beloved children, and in vs 8 at one time we were darkness, but now we are light in the Lord. Therefore, we should walk as children of light. In our passage today he commands us to be filled with the Spirit. We can't get more of the Spirit – he is a person, and if we are in Christ we have already been given him. So to be filled with the Spirit is an ongoing thing – it is a command to the church and is concerned with how we relate to each other. Paul gives us three ways to be filled with the Spirit.

First we are to sing to each other in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. We sing together to one another and to God, and as we sing we speak and teach the word of God to one another. So being filled with the Spirit is not a mystical experience, it leads us to speak the word of God to one another. Notice that the word and the Spirit go together, they can't be separated. The word without the Spirit lacks power, and we need the Spirit to apply the word to our lives. Music is a great gift from God that drives his word deep into our souls.

Then we are filled with the Spirit as we make melody in our hearts to the Lord. Singing and making music involves our whole being – body, soul and spirit. As we sing songs of praise to God we express the reality of life in the Spirit. The right truth with the right music drives that truth deep into our souls. So there is both the horizontal aspect of speaking and teaching God's word to each other and the vertical aspect of giving glory to God and praising him in the same activity. As we gather we come to share life together and to speak God's truth into each other's lives. The bold confession you sing today may be just what the person next to you needs at that time, and the what they sing may be just what you need.

Finally we are filled with the Spirit as we build thanksgiving into our lives and into our gathering as God's church. In vs 5 Paul calls covetousness idolatry. Thanksgiving is the opposite of idolatry and the antidote to the covetousness that corrupts us. Idolatry is giving anything in our lives greater importance than God. Whatever is most important in your life, give thanks to God for it and use it appropriately. Thanksgiving transforms covetousness into seeking God's will whatever the situation. The Spirit filled life transforms our basic self-centred orientation and lust for more into an orientation to others. We go from coveting what someone has into thanking God for it and seeking their good as we speak the truth of God into their lives.

God has given us a good gift in music and song. Let us be filled with the Spirit giving thanks to him for it and through it as we gather together as his church, speaking to one another in psalms, hymns and spiritual songs, making melody in our hearts to the Lord and giving thanks always and for everything to God our Father.

Prayer

Father, thank for the good gift you have given us in music and song. May we be filled with the Holy Spirit in our whole lives, but especially as we gather together as your people and share together in song and thanksgiving.

Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence or superior and current LBMCCC Club Membership Card and Log Book (if issued) at document check.

No rally, mud/snow or hand cut tyres on Driving Wheels.

20. CLASSES: As per Article 7 of the National Motorkhana Code.

21. RESULTS, PRIZES AND TROPHIES: Points towards LBMCCC Championship

Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, including penalties incurred.

Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code.

22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.

26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

30. ***Use of prohibited Substances***

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A and 145B of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). Other Prohibited Substances: the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and as amended from time to time, recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply. Additionally, in any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy conflict, the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy will apply.

31. A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a Motorkhana as described in 19.1 of the National Motorkhana Code.
