Devotions – May 2018

Introduction

The background to our story is in Exodus Ch 4-9, and our story is from Exodus Ch 9:13-28.

About 15 years after Ishmael was born to Hagar, Abraham and Sarah had a son named Isaac. He had sons, and his sons had sons. After 4 generations there was a major famine in the whole area. Now God had prepared it so that there was food available in Egypt, so the whole family moved to Egypt – there were about 70 of them in all.

They settled there for several hundred years and multiplied and multiplied to become the nation of Israel. Pharaoh, king of Egypt, began to fear them because they were so numerous, and so he set them to harsh slavery. They were in misery, and cried out to God, “Remember us, save us – when will you fulfil the promises you gave to our ancestor Abraham?”

God had prepared Moses. He said to Moses, “Go to Pharaoh, king of Egypt. Speak to him and say, ‘The LORD, God of the Israelites says, “Let my people go so that they may worship me.”’” Well Pharaoh just laughed. He said, “Who is this God of the Israelites that I should listen to him”. And he refused to let the people go. So God began to send plagues on Pharaoh. Up to this time there had been 6 plagues, each more severe than the last. During most of the plagues, Pharaoh would say, “Praise you Lord. Stop the plague and I will let you go.” But as soon as the plague finished, he changed his mind and refused to let them go. Our story comes from the 7th plague.

The Story

Exodus 9:13-28 ¹³ Then the Lord said to Moses, “Get up early in the morning, confront Pharaoh and say to him, ‘This is what the Lord, the God of the Hebrews, says: Let my people go, so that they may worship me, ¹⁴ or this time I will send the full force of my plagues against you and against your officials and your people, so you may know that there is no one like me in all the earth. ¹⁵ For by now I could have stretched out my hand and struck you and your people with a plague that would have wiped you off the earth. ¹⁶ But I have raised you up for this very purpose, that I might show you my power and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth. ¹⁷ You still set yourself against my people and will not let them go. ¹⁸ Therefore, at this time tomorrow I will send the worst hailstorm that has ever fallen on Egypt, from the day it was founded till now. ¹⁹ Give an order now to bring your livestock and everything you have in the field to a place of shelter, because the hail will fall on every person and animal that has not been brought in and is still out in the field, and they will die.’”

²⁰ Those officials of Pharaoh who feared the word of the Lord hurried to bring their slaves and their livestock inside. ²¹ But those who ignored the word of the Lord left their slaves and livestock in the field.

²² Then the Lord said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand toward the sky so that hail will fall all over Egypt—on people and animals and on everything growing in the fields of Egypt.” ²³ When Moses stretched out his staff toward the sky, the Lord sent thunder and hail, and lightning flashed down to the ground. So the Lord rained hail on the land of Egypt; ²⁴ hail fell and lightning flashed back and forth. It was the worst storm in all the land of Egypt since it had become a nation. ²⁵ Throughout Egypt hail struck everything in the fields—both people and animals; it beat down everything growing in the fields and stripped every tree. ²⁶ The only place it did not hail was the land of Goshen, where the Israelites were.

²⁷ Then Pharaoh summoned Moses and Aaron. “This time I have sinned,” he said to them. “The Lord is in the right, and I and my people are in the wrong. ²⁸ Pray to the Lord, for we have had enough thunder and hail. I will let you go; you don’t have to stay any longer.” (NIV)
