Devotions – September 2018

Introduction

Now Jesus and his disciples knew a family who lived in Bethany, a small village about an hour's walk away from Jerusalem. The brother's name was Lazarus and the sisters were Mary and Martha. One day Lazarus grew sick, and so the sisters immediately sent a servant to fetch Jesus, saying "Come quickly, Lazarus is very sick and we're afraid that he's going to die."

However, Jesus stayed where he was for another two days before setting out and by the time that he arrived in Bethany Lazarus had already been dead for four days. Martha, Lazarus's sister, said to him "Look, if you had come earlier then perhaps you could have healed my brother and he would not have died."

Jesus said to her "I am the Resurrection and the Life. If anyone believes in me he will never die."

Martha said "Yes, I know that on the last day we will be raised from the dead."

The Story

John 11:32-54 ³² When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."

³³ When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come along with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in spirit and troubled. ³⁴ "Where have you laid him?" he asked.

"Come and see, Lord," they replied.

³⁵ Jesus wept.

³⁶ Then the Jews said, "See how he loved him!"

³⁷ But some of them said, "Could not he who opened the eyes of the blind man have kept this man from dying?"

Jesus Raises Lazarus From the Dead

³⁸ Jesus, once more deeply moved, came to the tomb. It was a cave with a stone laid across the entrance. ³⁹ "Take away the stone," he said.

"But, Lord," said Martha, the sister of the dead man, "by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days."

⁴⁰ Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?"

⁴¹ So they took away the stone. Then Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. ⁴² I knew that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me."

⁴³ When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" ⁴⁴ The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face.

Jesus said to them, "Take off the grave clothes and let him go."

The Plot to Kill Jesus

⁴⁵ Therefore many of the Jews who had come to visit Mary, and had seen what Jesus did, believed in him. ⁴⁶ But some of them went to the Pharisees and told them what Jesus had done. ⁴⁷ Then the chief priests and the Pharisees called a meeting of the Sanhedrin.

"What are we accomplishing?" they asked. "Here is this man performing many signs. ⁴⁸ If we let him go on like this, everyone will believe in him, and then the Romans will come and take away both our temple and our nation."

⁴⁹ Then one of them, named Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, spoke up, "You know nothing at all! ⁵⁰ You do not realize that it is better for you that one man die for the people than that the whole nation perish."

⁵¹ He did not say this on his own, but as high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus would die for the Jewish nation, ⁵² and not only for that nation but also for the scattered children of God, to bring them together and make them one. ⁵³ So from that day on they plotted to take his life. All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and Log Book (if issued) at Document check.

22. CLASSES: As per Article 7 of the National Motorkhana Code

Class G Rear Wheel Drive Specials

Class H Production Vehicle Based Specials

Non Production 4WS (4 Wheel Steering) and 4wd vehicles are not permitted Motorkhana

(Nomination in a category does not preclude a Driver for competing for Class Awards)

23. PRIZES AND TROPHIES:

Motorkhana: 1st 2nd 3rd Outright,

1st in each Class (minimum of 3 class entrants required),
1st Junior & 1st Lady in Production and Special.

24. **TIMING, PENALTIES**

Each test to be run twice. Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties.

Timing shall be electronic by “break beam” and measuring to 0.001 second

Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code

Note : Course markers will be traffic cones that replace flags but will be called “flags” for the purpose of these regulations. Flag penalties will be determined by the Chief Timekeeper of that course and will be applied if the course flag is knocked over or moved from its original position.

25. The CAMS Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

26. The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

27. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

Preference will be given to Entrants registered for the State Motorkhana Championship until early entry closes at 6:00pm on Tuesday 11th of September. After this time, entry is open to all eligible Competitors on a first come basis.

Eligibility for preference for the 2018 State Motorkhana Championship will be determined based on results of Rounds 1 ~ 8 of the 2018 CAMS NSW Motorkhana Championship inclusive

28. Entries from Competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a Parent / Guardian.

29. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

30. Start and Finish procedures shall be in accordance with Article 13 of the National Motorkhana Code.

Running order shall be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, but in general will be the State field followed by the Multi-Club field.

31. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

32. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

33. Any holder of a CAMS ‘Competition’ or ‘Officials’ licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS ‘Competition’ or ‘Officials’ licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

34. **PASSENGERS** This Event will include a Motor Sport Passengers Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy and Motorkhana Regulations.

STATE: Only limited experience Junior Drivers are allowed to carry an experienced senior Passenger (Instructor) for the purpose of guidance. All Junior Drivers carrying a Passenger during competition are not eligible to score championship points in a State Motorkhana Championship Event. Times achieved by a Driver with a Passenger shall not be used as a basis for the application of penalties to other Drivers.

MULTI-CLUB: Passengers are welcome and encouraged.

PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy. Passengers are only allowed where their role is as an ‘Instructor’.

- (a) A Briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Instructors must:
 - i. Be experienced and have the permission of the Clerk of the Course. The suitability of the Passenger is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
 - ii. Wear the same protective gear as a Driver in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
 - iii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes.
 - iv. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and Disclaimer.
 - v. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.

- 35. Trailers must be moved to the other side of the tunnel once unloaded.
- 36. Food and drinks will be available to purchase at the venue.
- 37. Fuel is not available at the venue; the closest service station is on the corner of Brabham Dr and the Great Western Highway, a 5 minute drive away.
- 38. The day will consist of 2 Events if time permits

Event 1 – consists of up to 12 tests run twice each. This will determine the placings for the day
Event 2 – consists of two identical tests run simultaneously as a knockout format. Last Competitor unbeaten declared winner. This result does not count towards placings.

Under section 22 of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic), the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. 'Gross negligence' in relation to an act or omission, means doing the act or omitting to do an act with reckless disregard, with or without consciousness, for the consequences of the act or omission. See regulation 5 of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Regulations 2012 and section 22(3) (b) of the Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012.

WARNING APPLICABLE IN RELATION TO MOTOR SPORT ACTIVITIES HELD IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Your rights:

Under sections 60 and 61 of the Australian Consumer Law (SA), if a person in trade or commerce supplies you with services including recreational services), there is:

- a statutory guarantee that those services will be rendered with due care and skill;
- a statutory guarantee that those services, and any product resulting from those services, will be reasonably fit for the purpose for which the services are being acquired (as long as that purpose is made known to the supplier); and
- a statutory guarantee that those services, and any product resulting from those services, will be of such a nature, and quality, state or condition, that they might reasonably be expected to achieve the result that the consumer wishes to achieve (as long as that wish is made known to the supplier or a person with whom negotiations have been conducted in relation to the acquisition of the services).

Excluding, Restricting or Modifying Your Rights:

Under section 42 of the Fair Trading Act 1987 (SA), the supplier of recreational services is entitled to ask you to agree to exclude, restrict or modify his or her liability for any personal injury suffered by you or another person for whom or on whose behalf you are acquiring the services (a third party consumer). If you sign this form, you will be agreeing to exclude, restrict or modify the supplier's liability with the result that compensation may not be payable if you or the third party consumer suffer personal injury.

Important:

You do not have to agree to exclude, restrict or modify your rights by signing this form. The supplier may refuse to provide you with the services if you do not agree to exclude, restrict or modify your rights by signing this form. Even if you sign this form, you may still have further legal rights against the supplier. A child under the age of 18 cannot legally agree to exclude, restrict or modify his or her rights. A parent or guardian of a child who acquires recreational services for the child cannot legally agree to exclude, restrict or modify the child's rights.

Agreement to exclude, restrict or modify your rights:

I agree that the liability of CAMS and the Entities for any personal injury that may result from the supply of the recreational services that may be suffered by me (or a person for whom or on whose behalf I am acquiring the services) is excluded.

DEFINITIONS:

- a. 'CAMS' means the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd.
- b. 'Claim' means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand or cause of action however arising including but not limited to negligence, BUT does not include a claim under a CAMS insurance policy by any person expressly entitled to make a claim under that insurance policy;
- c. 'Entities' means event and competition organisers/promoters/managers, land and track owners/managers/administrators/lessees, CAMS affiliated clubs, state and territory governments and insured listed in CAMS' public/product/professional indemnity insurance policies and each of their related bodies corporate (including their related bodies corporate) and each of their organs and agencies, officers/president/directors/executives, employees, servants, agents, partners, providers, members, competitors, drivers, co-drivers, navigators, officials, crew members, pit crew, delegates, licence holders, representatives, commissions, committees, advisers, trustees, councils, panels, shareholders, volunteers, officials, appointees, delegated bodies and sponsors.
- d. 'Motor Sport Activities' means any motor sport activities or Recreational Services which are permitted or approved which CAMS regulates or administers by CAMS or otherwise under the responsibility / control of CAMS;
- e. 'Reckless Conduct' means conduct where the supplier of the recreational services is aware, or should reasonably have been aware, of a significant risk that the conduct could result in personal injury to another person and engages in the conduct despite the risk and without adequate justification;
- f. 'Recreational Services' means (unless otherwise defined in this document) services that consist of participation in:
 - a) a sporting activity; or
 - b) a similar leisure time pursuit or any other activity that:
 - (i) involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
 - (ii) is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.
