### Devotions – November 2018

#### Introduction

Jesus had told his disciples on many occasions “I will be crucified, and then on the third day I will rise again”, but they never understood him or took in this information.

On the Sunday morning after Jesus had been crucified on the Friday the disciples were meeting together. A group of women burst into the meeting saying “Jesus is alive! Jesus is alive! When we went to the tomb we saw an angel and he said to us, “Why do you look for the living among the dead. He is not here but has been raised just as he said he would.” But the disciples didn’t believe the women – they thought they were crazy.

Later that day two men came running to the disciples saying “We’ve seen Jesus! We’ve seen Jesus! We were walking along the road when a stranger came up and joined us. At first, we didn’t recognise him, but when we stopped and he broke the bread for us our eyes were opened and we recognised him. Then suddenly he disappeared.”

#### The Story

Luke 24:36-53 <sup>36</sup> While they were still talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, “Peace be with you.”

<sup>37</sup> They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost. <sup>38</sup> He said to them, “Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds? <sup>39</sup> Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have.”

<sup>40</sup> When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet. <sup>41</sup> And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, “Do you have anything here to eat?” <sup>42</sup> They gave him a piece of broiled fish, <sup>43</sup> and he took it and ate it in their presence.

<sup>44</sup> He said to them, “This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms.”

<sup>45</sup> Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. <sup>46</sup> He told them, “This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, <sup>47</sup> and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of these things. <sup>49</sup> I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.”

#### The Ascension of Jesus

<sup>50</sup> When he had led them out to the vicinity of Bethany, he lifted up his hands and blessed them. <sup>51</sup> While he was blessing them, he left them and was taken up into heaven. <sup>52</sup> Then they worshiped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy. <sup>53</sup> And they stayed continually at the temple, praising God.
