Devotions – October 2018

Introduction

Jesus had chosen his 12 disciples, and they travelled around with him for about 3 years, seeing what he was doing and hearing what he was saying. But really, they had misunderstood his purpose. They thought that he had come to establish an earthly kingdom, to conquer the Romans and make Israel a great nation. When Jesus said, “My purpose is to be crucified and to die and then be raised from the dead 3 days later” the disciples still didn’t understand even though he had said it many times.

Now the Jews celebrated 3 great festivals each year where they all travelled to Jerusalem and went to the temple. One was called the Feast of Tabernacles, which some churches still celebrate as a harvest festival. One was called the Day of Atonement. On this occasion each year the High Priest would prepare a special sacrifice for the nation, and God would forgive their sins. He did this by entering the part of the temple called the Holy of Holies. This was the innermost most sacred section of the temple separated from the rest of the temple by a great curtain – perhaps the greatest curtain in the whole ancient world. God had said that no one could enter the Holy of Holies or they would die because God is holy, and no one can stand in his presence because of their sin. But on this one occasion each year the High Priest could enter in to make sacrifice for the nation. He would enter in with the blood of a lamb, and God said, “I will continue to be your God and forgive you for this year”. So the curtain symbolises this separation between God and humanity.

Our story occurs at the time of the third great festival – the Passover, where the Jews celebrated their rescue from Egypt, their salvation story, their New Year, the time when they went from being slaves to getting their freedom. It was when they put the blood of the lamb on their doorposts, and God saw the blood and passed over their homes as he killed the firstborn of every Egyptian family.

Now the Jews had been plotting to kill Jesus since he had raised Lazarus from the dead. Judas, one of the disciples, decided to betray Jesus to the Jews, and so they paid him and he led them to Jesus, where they arrested him, beat him and sent him to Pilate the Roman governor who weakened under their pressure, and handed him over for crucifixion.

The Story

Luke 23:32-47 ³² Two other men, both criminals, were also led out with him to be executed. ³³ When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified him there, along with the criminals—one on his right, the other on his left. ³⁴ Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.

³⁵ The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, “He saved others; let him save himself if he is God’s Messiah, the Chosen One.”

³⁶ The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar ³⁷ and said, “If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself.”

³⁸ There was a written notice above him, which read: this is the king of the jews.

³⁹ One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: “Aren’t you the Messiah? Save yourself and us!”

⁴⁰ But the other criminal rebuked him. “Don’t you fear God,” he said, “since you are under the same sentence? ⁴¹ We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong.”

⁴² Then he said, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.”

⁴³ Jesus answered him, “Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise.”

⁴⁴ It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon, ⁴⁵ for the sun stopped shining. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. ⁴⁶ Jesus called out with a loud voice, “Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.” When he had said this, he breathed his last.

⁴⁷ The centurion, seeing what had happened, praised God and said, “Surely this was a righteous man.” (NIV)
